Cocaine Anonymous (CA) Ireland is a fellowship of men and women who share their experience, strength and hope with each other so that they may solve their common problem and help others to recover from their addiction. Everything heard at a CA meeting is to be treated as confidential. There are no dues or fees for membership; it is fully supporting through its own contributions.

The program, called the Twelve Steps of Recovery is gratefully borrowed from the fellowship Alcoholics Anonymous, who has experience with substance abuse since the late 1930's. CA is concerned solely with the personal recovery and continued sobriety of individual drug addicts who turn to this Fellowship for help. Cocaine Anonymous is open to all persons who state a desire to stop using cocaine, including 'crack' cocaine, as well as all other mind-altering substances.
